## 17th INAP Conference Report from Mokpo Newport

The 17<sup>th</sup> International Network of Affiliated Ports ("INAP") Conference with the theme "The Eco Port Policy of INAP" was held in Mokpo City from 1-2 September 2015.

As you know, INAP was organized in 1998 as a group of sister ports in order to expand exchange and activities among its members and currently, there are 8 ports, with the Port of Kochi, Japan, the Port of Colombo, Sri Lanka, the port of Qingdao in China, the ports of Subic Bay and Cebu in the Philippines, the Port of Tanjung Perak, Indonesia and the Port of Dangjin and Mokpo Newport in Korea.
