18th INAP 2016 Conference Report

The Cebu Port Authority, on behalf of its management and staff, would like to convey its heartfelt appreciation for the enthusiastic participation of the member ports. It was so uplifting to see all the delegates congregate for the 18th INAP Conference, seeing again familiar faces.

This year's 18th INAP Conference was the third time that the Port of Cebu had hosted. It was held last September 6-7, 2016 with the theme, "The Ports Amidst the Challenge of Climate Change", at the Jpark Island Resort and Waterpark, Lapulapu City, Cebu, Philippines.

Delegates from the affiliated member Ports of Tanjung Perak, Indonesia; Kochi, Japan, Dangjin and Mokpo, both of South Korea, Colombo, Sri Lanka and the Subic and Davao, both of Philippines arrived the day before the event, some on the first day of the event.

The International Network of Affiliated Ports (INAP) is an association of affiliated ports created in 1998 for the purpose of discussing matters of mutual interest, consultation, cooperation and exchange of information on expertise, marketing, planning, technology, skills and overall port development.

The highlight of the Conference was the presentations and discussions of the affiliated member ports on the various updates in their maritime operations, exchange of information, significant port developments and best practices in maritime port operations.

A total of ninety-eight (98) delegates from all the member ports attended the Conference, including the Port of Cebu. Cebu port stakeholders from the cargo handlers and the shipping industry also participated.
