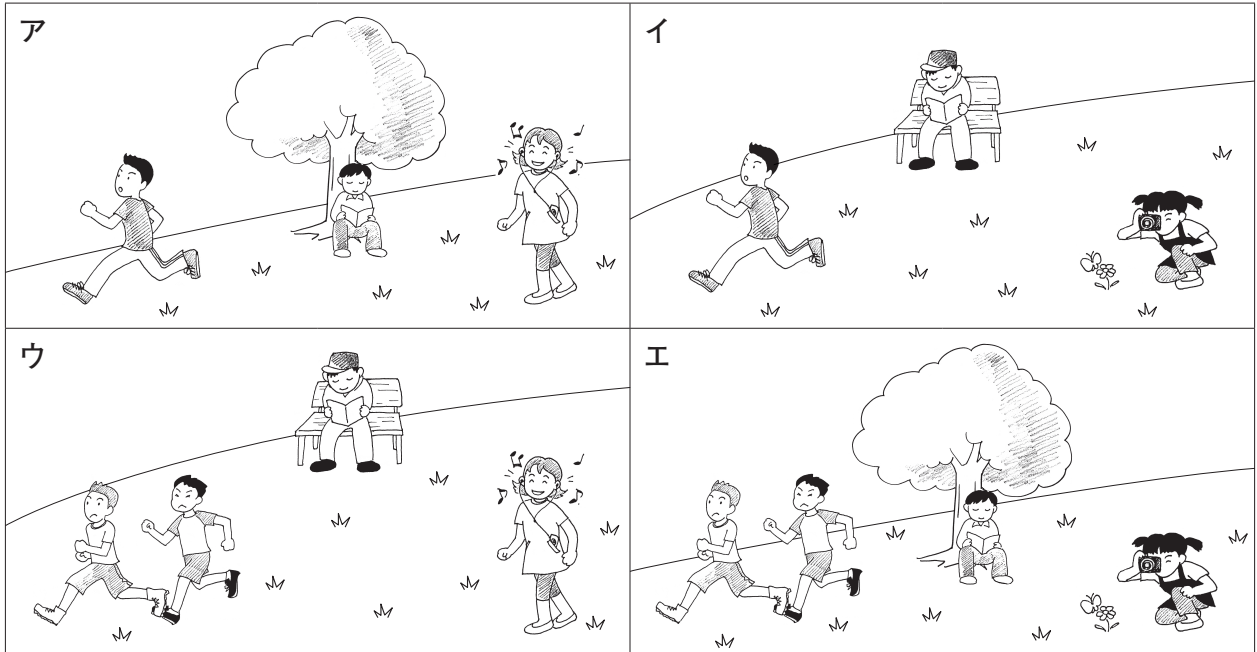

Kenta : That's true.

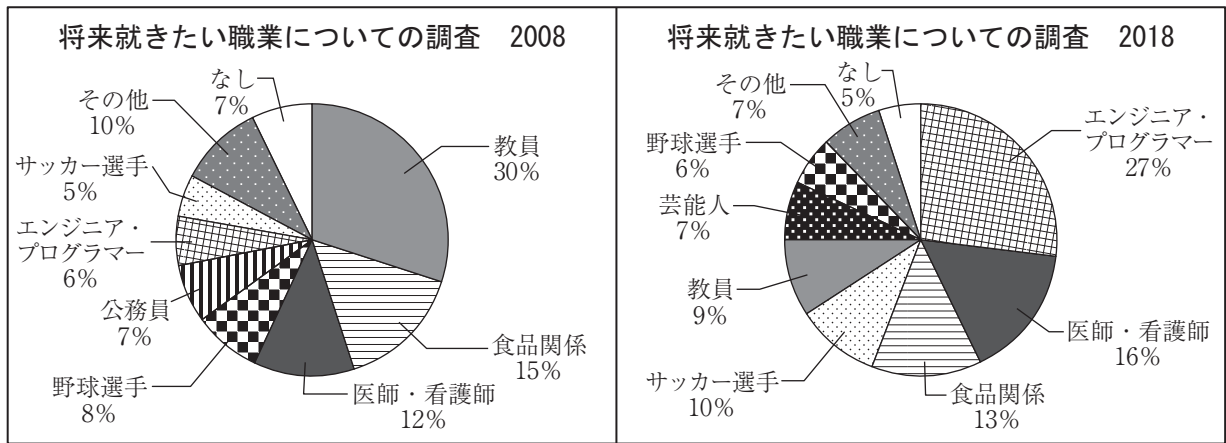
Ms. Smith : In 2018, we can see a new job, entertainer. It is not in the 2008 graph.

Kenta : Yes. That is the job I'm really interested in.

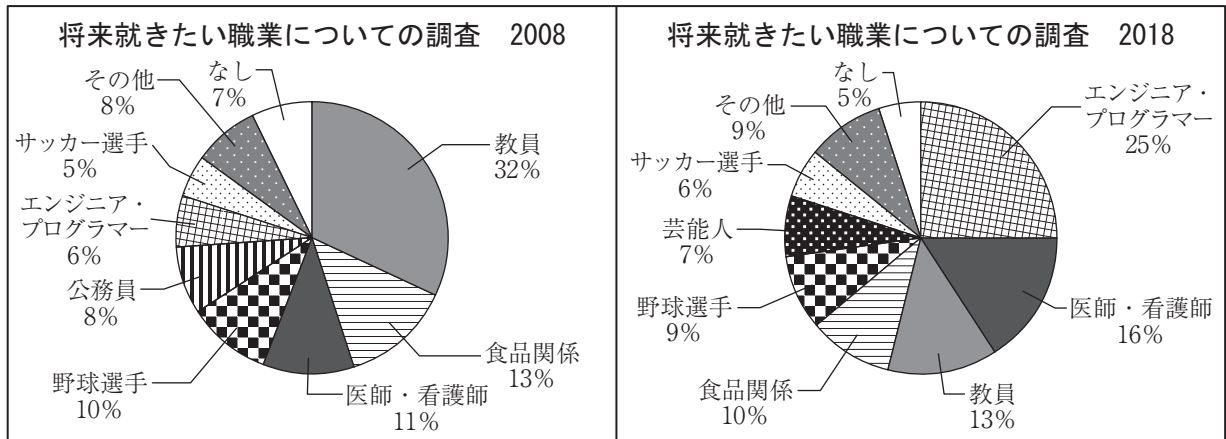
Ms. Smith : Really? I thought you wanted to be an English teacher.

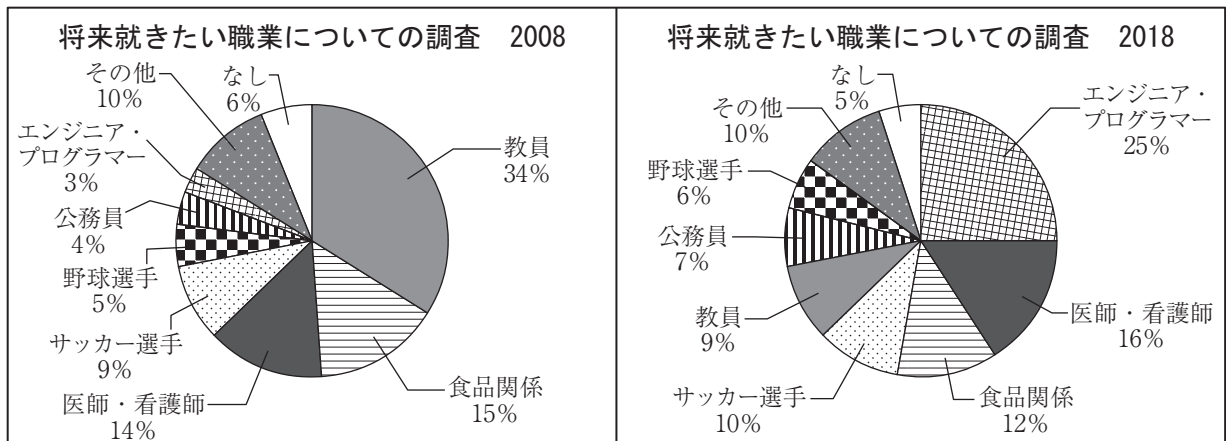

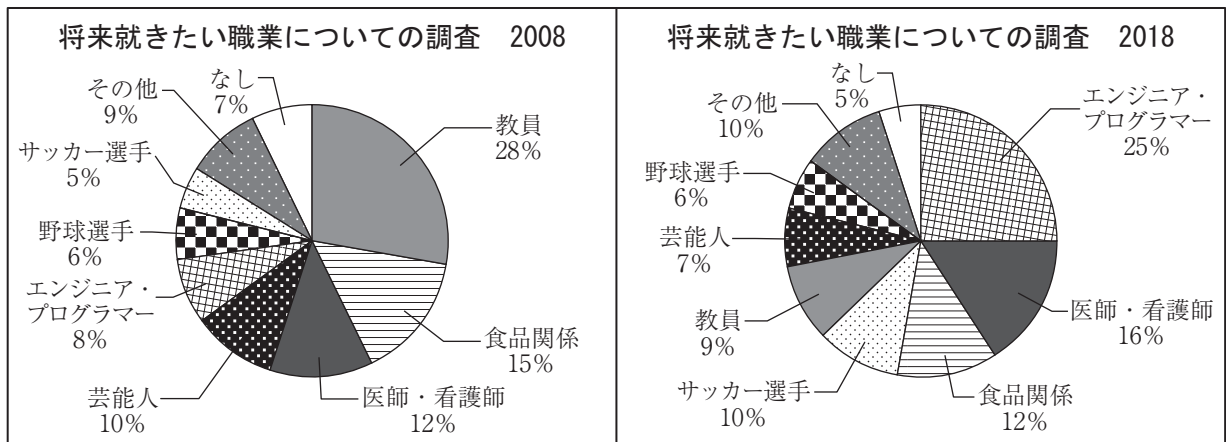

It is always busy, especially on Sundays. “Suzuki” is a very popular shop. Mr. Suzuki and his daughter run the shop. Many people like their Japanese sweets.

On the morning of the first day, Mr. Suzuki’s daughter, Aya, showed me how to greet customers. She said, “Greeting customers with a smile is very important. When we smile at them, they feel happy and enjoy shopping.” I practiced the greeting many times with Aya. She said to me, “You did very well. You will be a good salesclerk.” I was very glad to hear that. In the afternoon, she took me to the kitchen. I saw a lot of Japanese sweets there. They were very beautiful and the colors were bright. Some of them looked like flowers. She showed me how to make some sweets. I tried making some, but it was very difficult. She said, “My father taught me how to make sweets when I was a child.
